## Traffic Management Change on Kay Road and Tunis Road

Kia ora Neighbour,

We would like to update you on development activity in your neighbourhood. Here's what you need to know.

As mentioned in the September Development Community Update, there will be a change in traffic management on Kay Road and Tunis Road to help keep everyone safe while the stormwater upgrade work continues. This traffic setup will be in place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. To make getting around easier, please see the attached map for recommended detour routes.

## How this will impact you

- Traffic Management
  - o Kay Road: Vehicle access for residents to remain accessible via Tunis Road.
  - o **Tunis Road:** No vehicle access between 24 and 30 Tunis Road. Vehicles will need to use appropriate side streets as detours, please refer to map for guidance.
- On-Street Parking: Street parking within the work zones and along detour routes will be restricted. These areas are highlighted in yellow on map below.
