# October Community Update Alamein Road, Dunkirk Road, Larsen Road, Tripoli Road, Kay Road and Tunis Road

Kia ora Neighbour,

We would like to update you on development activity in your neighbourhood this October. Here's what you need to know.

## Service disruptions

There will be some upcoming water and power planned outages in your area. Utility providers will send more details to the account holder. You can also check for planned outages by searching your address on Vector or Watercare websites.

#### Alamein Road

Last month we expected to reinstate the affected footpaths and driveways along 2–10 Alamein Road and properties 1A–3 Alamein Road. LEAD Alliance Senior Community Liaison will be in touch closer to the time with another update confirming the planned dates for this work.

#### **Dunkirk Road**

Vector will be continuing upgrades along the roadside berm of Mt Wellington War Memorial Reserve.

#### Larsen Road

Vector and Chorus are near the final stages of their upgrade works through this month. This will include removing the overhead lines and poles within the upgraded area and new streetlight installations.

A road closure will be put in place in the first week of this month to assist in completing stormwater upgrade and the reinstatement of footpaths and driveways between properties 7 and 21. A detailed letter with traffic management information and confirmed duration of dates will be sent to residents before the closure.

## Tripoli Road & Kay Road

The stormwater upgrades, which tie into the Johnson Reserve upgrade, are progressing up Kay Road towards Tunis Road.

#### **Tunis Road**

Stormwater upgrades will progress towards the end of this month, continuing up to Tunis Road. A detailed letter with full traffic management information was delivered on the 25 September. If you would like a digital copy, please contact Kirrily. Road and footpath reinstatement will follow.

## **Key information**

We will keep disruption to a minimum, but please expect the following standard impacts:

• Loss of driveway access for vehicles: Vehicle access to some driveways may be temporarily restricted. To receive timely updates, please text or email Kirrily with your name, address, and preferred contact details.





- Traffic management: Street parking in the immediate work areas, marked by cones, will be restricted during working hours of 7:30am to 6:00pm, Monday to Friday, and on Saturday if required.
  - o <u>Alamein & Larsen Road</u>: Traffic management will change at different times throughout this month. Please follow the traffic management signs in place to safely navigate around the area. Keep an eye on your letterbox for further details about the upcoming road closure on Larsen Road.
  - o <u>Tripoli Road</u>: The existing one-way detour that is in place is expected to be removed on the 4 October.
  - Kay & Tunis Road: Existing road closure to remain in place on Kay Road and Tunis Road.
- **Noise and vibration:** This work will involve activities such as excavation, concrete cutting, and the use of compactor plates. We will try to keep noise and vibration to a minimum.
