## **Infrastructure Works and Traffic Management Notice**

### **Glen Innes Northwest – Stage 2**

Kia ora Neighbour,

We are writing to let you know about upcoming infrastructure works in your neighbourhood as part of the Glen Innes Northwest Stage 2 project. These works are essential to support new warm, dry homes and upgraded infrastructure for our local community.

Construction is expected to begin in early March 2026 and will progress in stages across the area, with completion targeted for August 2026. As part of this programme, temporary traffic management will be in place on selected streets between **March and April 2026**, with further updates provided as works move through the neighbourhood.

### **What to expect**

#### **Working hours**

Monday to Friday, 7:30am – 6:00pm  
Saturdays, 7:30am – 6:00pm (if required)

#### **Construction impacts**

As works move through the area, you may notice:

- Temporary changes to traffic conditions
- Reduced on-street parking in designated areas
- Construction noise and dust
- Construction crews and equipment operating locally

We will do our best to minimise disruption and complete the work safely and efficiently. Emergency vehicle access will always be prioritised.

### **Traffic management – March to April 2026**

#### **Temporary traffic measures will include:**

**Heatherbank Street:** One-way vehicle access

**Evandale Street:** Resident access only

**Huxley Street:** Resident access only

**Selected areas:** Full road closures to vehicle traffic (see map attached)

Traffic management will remain in place 24 hours a day, 7 days a week during this period.

Pedestrian and cycle access will remain open at all times, with safe routes clearly marked.

On-street parking restrictions will apply in designated areas, both during and outside working hours. These areas will be clearly marked with cones and signage. Please follow all temporary road signs while traffic management is in place.

A map is included with this letter outlining the areas impacted during **March and April**. Further notices will be provided as the project progresses into new stages.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation while this important work is carried out to improve infrastructure in Glen Innes.
