## We're making it safer to navigate the Apirana, Merton, Line, and Pt England Road roundabout

Kia ora,

We are constructing pedestrian and cyclist crossings, and cycle lane connections along with road maintenance, at the Apirana/Merton/Line/Pt England roundabout.

Work will take place from Monday 5 January for 8 weeks. Our main hours of work are between 7 am to 7 pm. If required, we may work during the evening and overnight.

Please note that wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay the start or completion of the works. If there are significant delays, we will keep you informed.

These works are part of the Links to Glen Innes Cycleways project, which aims to create more options for people to travel safely and sustainably in our growing communities. To find out more about the Links to Glen Innes Cycleways project visit at.govt.nz/links2Gl or scan the QR code.



Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:


Where	Apirana Avenue south, Pt England Road, and Line Road approaches (please refer to the maps below to see where we'll be working)
When	Work around the roundabout will be completed over approximately 8 weeks. We will be working in three stages to minimise the level of disruption:
	<ul> <li>Stage 1: Apirana Avenue south approach (4 weeks)</li> <li>Stage 2: Point England Road approach (2 weeks)</li> <li>Stage 3: Line Road approach (2 weeks)</li> </ul>
What we're doing	At the Line Road and Pt England Road approaches we will be delivering new zebra crossings with pedestrian islands.
	At the Apirana Avenue south approach, we will be constructing a raised cyclist and pedestrian crossing.
	We will also deliver road maintenance and renewal works, including footpath, kerb and channel upgrades.
How it may impact you	On-street parking will be limited during the works.
	At times our work may be noisy. We will carry out noisier activities during daytime hours to minimise disruption at night.
How travel is affected	A full or partial road closure will be in place for 24 hours a day at the roundabout approach where works are being carried out.
	Traffic controllers will be on site to assist drivers and pedestrians around the work site.
	Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.

Stage 1: Apirana Avenue south approach (4 weeks)








Stage 2: Point England Road approach (2 weeks)
