We're doing maintenance and renewal work on Line Road, Glen Innes

Kia ora,

We are doing road maintenance and renewal works along the eastern side of Line Road, Glen Innes.

Work will take place from 27 August to 8 October 2025, between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm (Monday to Saturday). Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start or completion of the works. If the delay is significant, we will notify you.

Road maintenance keeps our transport infrastructure in good condition so your travel around Auckland is as safe, swift and enjoyable as possible, whichever way you choose to do it. To minimise disruption to the community, we're carrying out these works at the same time as the Links to Glen Innes Cycleways project.

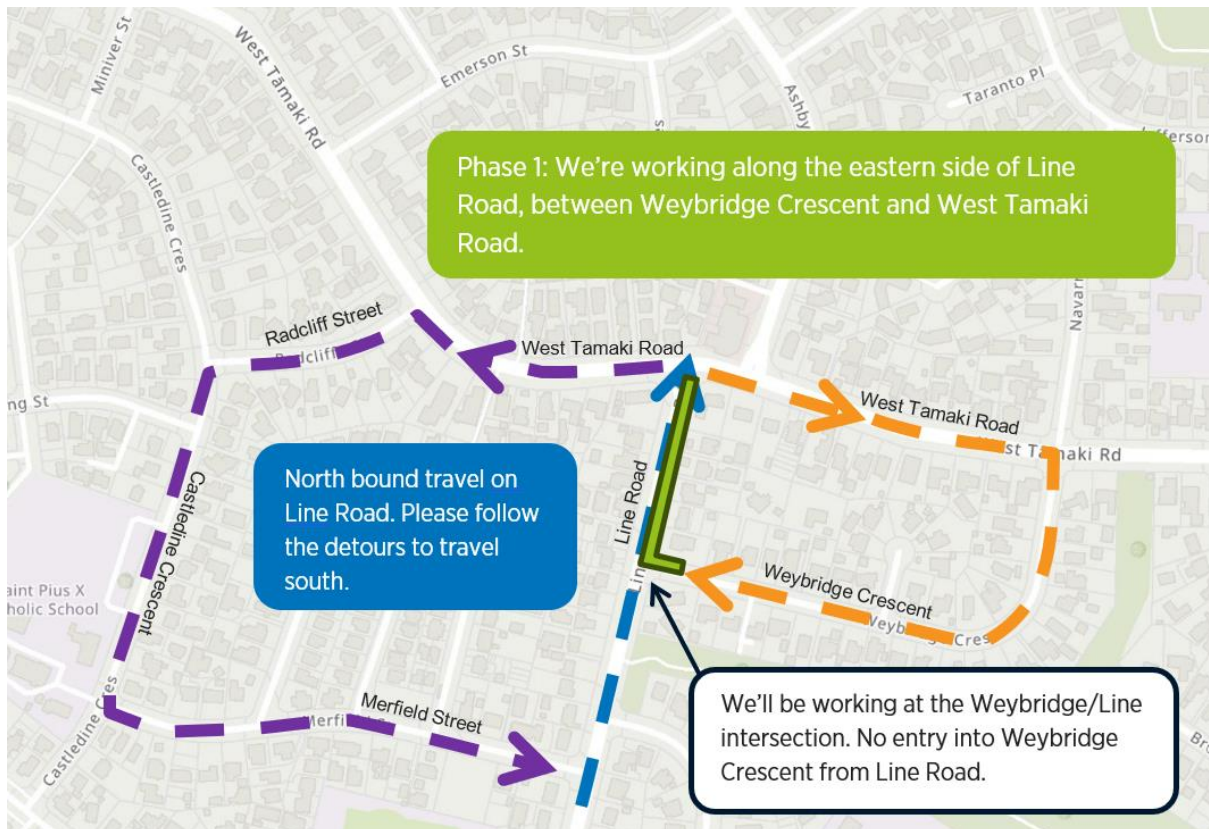

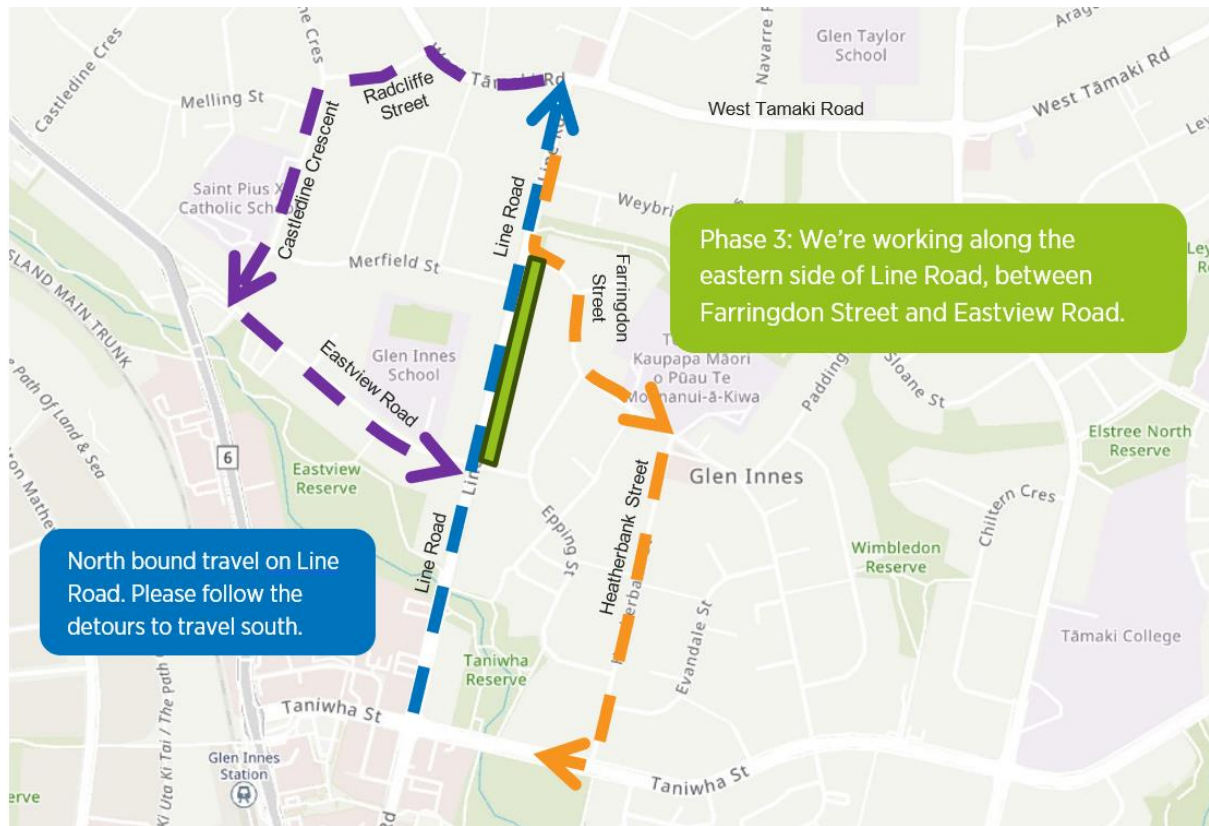


Here is what you need to know about the work happening near you:

Where	Line Road, Glen Innes (Eastern side) (see location map below)
When	<p>Work along the eastern side of Line Road will be completed over 6 weeks.</p> <p>We will be working in three, two-week phases to minimise the level of disruption:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phase 1: Between West Tamaki Road to Weybridge Crescent • Phase 2: Between Weybridge Crescent to Farringdon Street • Phase 3: Between Farringdon Street to Eastview Road
What we're doing	Delivering road maintenance and renewal works along the eastern side of Line Road. This includes footpath, kerb and channel upgrades, followed by asphalt resurfacing.
How it may impact you	On-street parking will be limited during works. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property.
How travel is affected	<p>A one-way detour will be in place to redirect traffic around the work site (see detour map below). This detour will be in place 24/7 while works are happening.</p> <p>Traffic controllers will be on site to assist drivers and pedestrians around the work site. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.</p>
